1. Warsaw Essentials

These are the top attractions that you simply shouldn't miss during your time in Warsaw! First off, take a walk around the **Old Town**, where you can see the **Royal Castle** with its two original Rembrandt canvases, as well as the **Cathedral** and the **Mermaid Statue**. Then enjoy a stroll along the **Royal Route**, with its many shops and charming cafes. Or visit the **Palace of Culture and Science** – the second tallest building in Poland and a prime example of social-realism architecture – and its viewing terrace on the 30th floor which overlooks the entire city and affords a perfect view of all the parks and green spaces that cover nearly half the city's area. Then you can take a leisurely stroll through one of the historical gardens, like the **Royal Łazienki Museum** which consists of neoclassical architecture and beautiful green areas, or the **Saxon Garden**. Finally, the city also boasts a number of excellent museums, such as the **Fryderyk Chopin Museum** which holds the world's largest collection of Chopin memorabilia, the **National Museum in Warsaw**, and the multimedia-filled **Warsaw Rising Museum** which will give you a better understanding of the city's unique identity.

SIGHTSEEING OF WARSAW

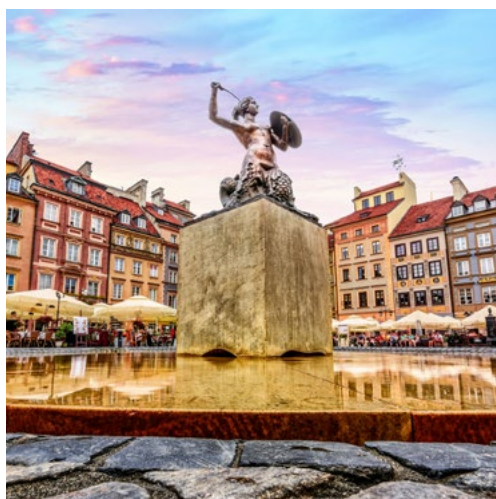

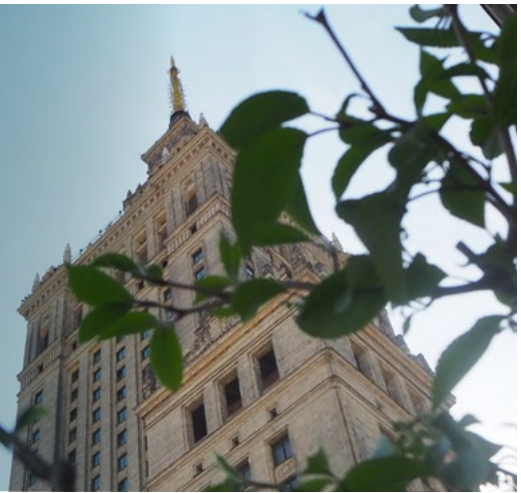


The Palace of Culture and Science

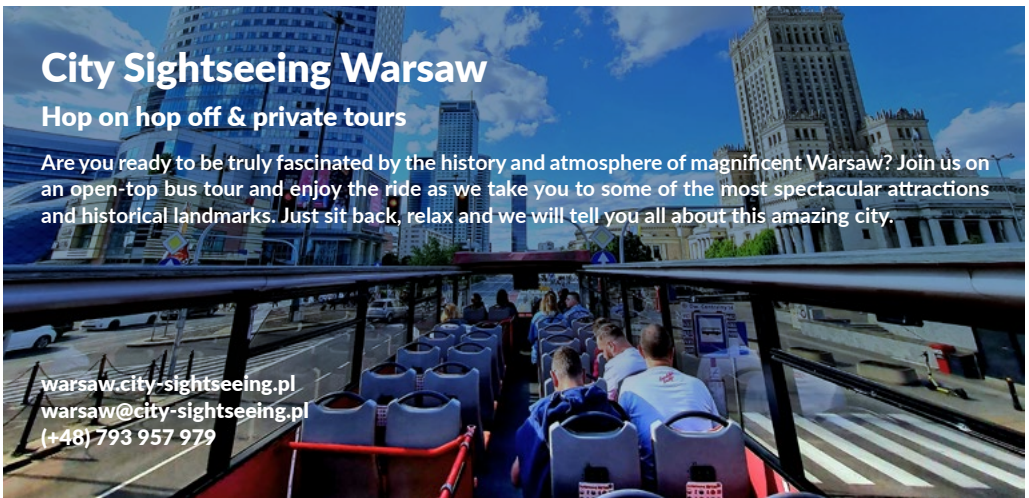

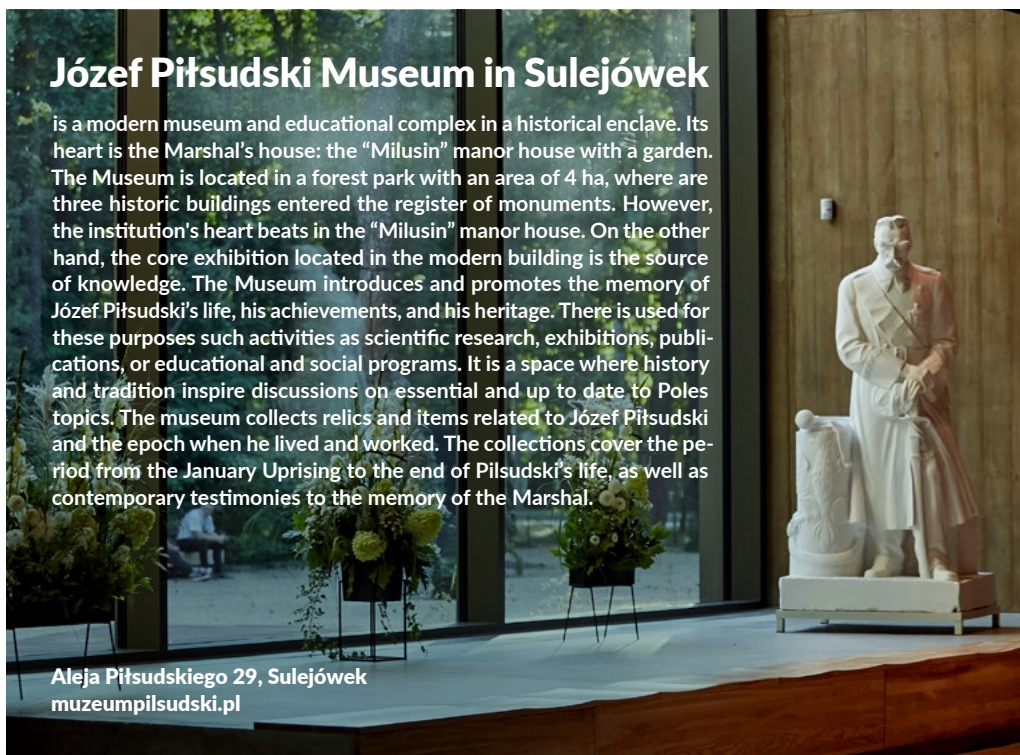

Józef Piłsudski Museum in Sulejówek

is a modern museum and educational complex in a historical enclave. Its heart is the Marshal's house: the "Milusin" manor house with a garden. The Museum is located in a forest park with an area of 4 ha, where are three historic buildings entered the register of monuments. However, the institution's heart beats in the "Milusin" manor house. On the other hand, the core exhibition located in the modern building is the source of knowledge. The Museum introduces and promotes the memory of Józef Piłsudski's life, his achievements, and his heritage. There is used for these purposes such activities as scientific research, exhibitions, publications, or educational and social programs. It is a space where history and tradition inspire discussions on essential and up to date to Poles topics. The museum collects relics and items related to Józef Piłsudski and the epoch when he lived and worked. The collections cover the period from the January Uprising to the end of Piłsudski's life, as well as contemporary testimonies to the memory of the Marshal.

The Warsaw Gaswork Museum

- The Warsaw Gasworks Museum is a unique place on the historical map of Warsaw. WGM is located in Wola and is housed in one of the buildings, the former municipal gasworks built in the 1888. A historical part of the museum is available for visitors, in which there are monuments of technology, even 120 years old, showing the visitors the appearance and operation of the former gasworks. The second part of the exhibition consists of modern interactive systems that present the process of gas formation and its application in the economy and industry.

2. City of Fryderyk Chopin



Discover the city of Fryderyk Chopin, one of the world's greatest composers, who was born in **Żelazowa Wola** and moved to Warsaw shortly after. The journey starts at the **Warsaw Chopin Airport**, which was named after the musician, and the most important stops along the way include the **Fryderyk Chopin Museum**, with the world's largest collection of Chopin memorabilia, the **Holy Cross Church**, where his heart is entombed, and his monument in the **Royal Łazienki Museum**, where open-air concerts are held every Sunday afternoon from May to September. See the one and only **Chopin pedestrian crosswalk**, designed in the style of a piano keyboard, and sit on one of the numerous **Chopin benches** dotted around the city, near the most important Chopin landmarks, to enjoy his music at the single press of a button.



FOLLOWING THE TRACES OF CHOPIN

Discover Warsaw of Frederic's youth on a tour down the Royal Route. Visit the University campus where Chopin lived for ten years. Find out more about his education, childhood friends and first great love. See the Holy Cross church, where the composer's heart is laid. After the tour you may listen to Chopin's music played at an evening concert in the Old Town. Find out more about Chopin's origin and extend your tour to a visit to his birthplace and a picturesque park. Get away to the Polish countryside for a relaxing half-day experience.

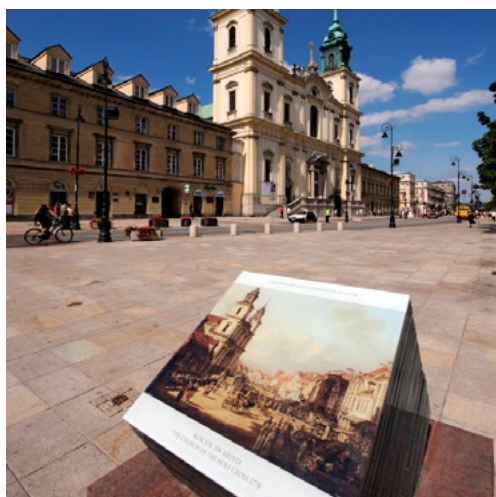

Moreover, on every seat, there is a map that will show you where you can find other locations with these unique benches.

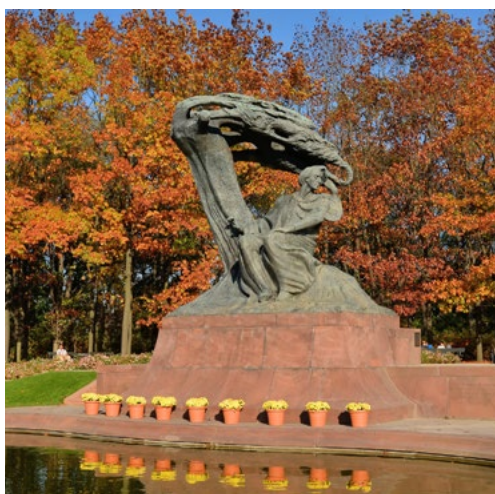

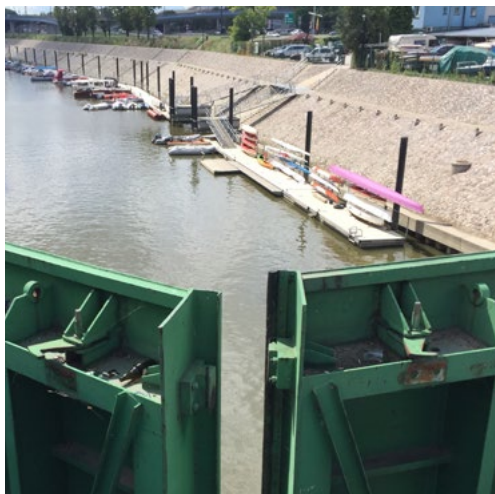






4. Communism tours



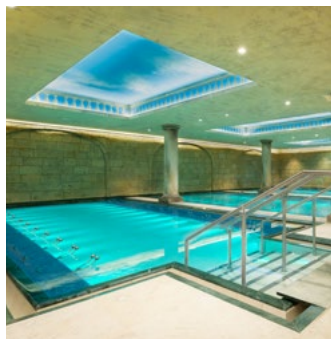

Piaseczno is a town located 18 kilometers from the center of Warsaw. You can easily get there by public transport bus or regional train. The **narrow-gauge railway station** is a historic place, the brick buildings hide many technical curiosities related to the railway. Historic trains leave from the station called Piaseczno Miasto. During the trip, a **picnic** is organized on the huge green glade where you can play darts, play football or go for a walk in the forest. The campsite is also an ideal place to spread a blanket and rest. You can also bake sausages on a fire. The trip lasts approximately five hours and passengers return by train to the same station from which they departed. On Saturdays and Sundays we organize public tours, for which you can easily buy a ticket online. 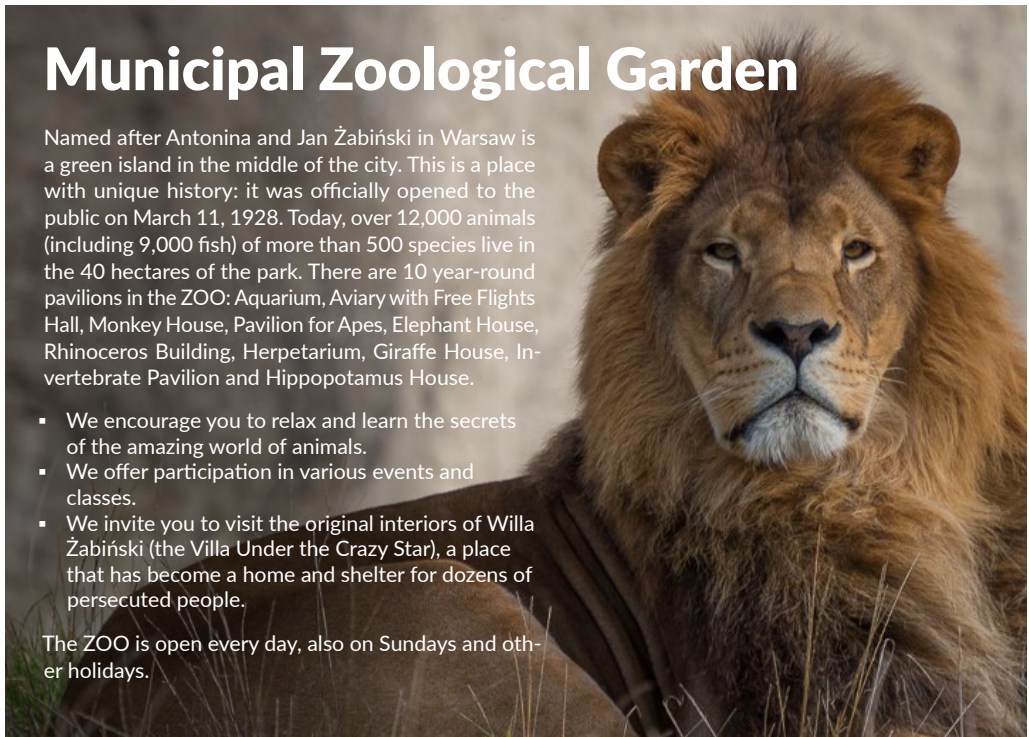

Municipal Zoological Garden

Named after Antonina and Jan Żabiński in Warsaw is a green island in the middle of the city. This is a place with unique history: it was officially opened to the public on March 11, 1928. Today, over 12,000 animals (including 9,000 fish) of more than 500 species live in the 40 hectares of the park. There are 10 year-round pavilions in the ZOO: Aquarium, Aviary with Free Flights Hall, Monkey House, Pavilion for Apes, Elephant House, Rhinoceros Building, Herpetarium, Giraffe House, Invertebrate Pavilion and Hippopotamus House.

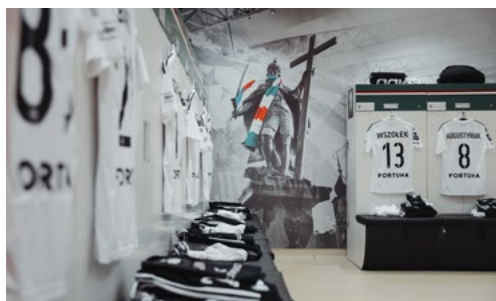

Sporty Vistula!

Cycling lanes, jogging lanes, harbors – enthusiasts of active leisure on the Vistula River have plenty to choose from! A special fitness trail winds along the “wild” right bank. If you happen to cycle in this neighborhood, for example, you can use the climbing wall or go skateboarding by the Świętokrzyski Bridge, do flatland skimming near the zoo, play volleyball and other things by the Poniatowski Bridge, or try your hand at archery once you reach Goćław. The left bank of the river is primarily boulevards. On their new central stretch, you can find, among other things, trampolines and spraygrounds. It is well worth stopping at an outdoor gym and a workout zone by the Flotilla Wiślana Boulevard or the Czerniakowski Port. More and more sailing opportunities are opening up all the time. From May on, the river is open both to large vessels which will take you on an all-day cruise out from the city, as well as traditional wooden boats and kayaks offering hour-long pleasure cruises, e.g. at sunset. On the Płyta Desantu you can find a brand-new paddle tennis court. Also available are free ferries joining the opposite banks which can be used for transporting bikes. This coming season will see open-air training sessions of yoga, roller skiing and tai chi.





Bicycle Warsaw

In Warsaw, you can also spend your free time in an active way! It's a city that can be proud of its bicycle infrastructure which constantly develops and grows bigger.

The bicycle system in Warsaw has approximately **735 km of routes!**

Cycling in Warsaw doesn't only have to be a way of recreation or rest. It can be as well a fantastic way of active sightseeing because there are many bike paths situated near many essential and iconic monuments, museums, or parks. The longest, and according to many people, the most interesting bike trail is located **along the Vistula river** and it has 37 km in length!

While riding on this specific trail you can pass the Ujazdowski Castle, the Royal Łazienki Museum, or Copernicus Science Centre.

Nevertheless, by deciding to use a bike in Warsaw, you also got a chance to visit those less touristic places and districts in the city and to see the capital of Poland from new perspectives – for example, by choosing the trail of Warsaw battles, where you'll be able to see the district of Praga and Wawer, where many different battles in the history took place.



Veturilo which is Warsaw Public Bike System, is with us since 2012. During all those years, Veturilo was rented nearly 34 million times, and over 1.5 million people registered to this system. From March 2023 we can use the new Veturilo bikes and app after they have been refreshed and renewed. What's changed is that all the users right now can also both rent and return bikes outside of the bike stations. There is no need to pin bikes to the electric strikes because now, bicycle locks are built into the bikes. All the bikes are brand new. Moreover, 10% of those bikes are electric ones.

For now, there are **3000 bikes** put into service, of which **300 are electric**, nevertheless, this number will grow.

Veturilo is an amazing system that you can use while being in Warsaw and when you don't have your own bike with you. It's really affordable!

But when it comes to bikes, we won't finish with Warsaw. There are many suburban cities and villages like **Piaseczno** which has its own unique bike trails, for example, **Jeziorki Land** which contains **over 400 km** of bike trails situated in the Jeziorki river valley. You can not only spend active and quality time there, but also experience real adventure, participate in an interesting event, be close to nature, see many beautiful and iconic places, and at the end – eat well!

PGE Narodowy stadium is one of the most modern multi-purpose arenas in the world, where several hundred spectacular music and sporting events have taken place over the past 11 years. The stadium has hosted some of the world's most prominent stars such as Coldplay, Rammstein, Andrea Bocelli, Sting or Ed Sheeran, whose concerts in 2022 attracted a record number of 150,000 fans. It is also the venue of the Speedway World Cup, matches of the Polish national football team as well as numerous trade fairs and conferences. The stadium has also hosted the NATO summit and US President Joe Biden.

The best way to discover the arena's secrets is to take part in a guided tour, during which you can learn

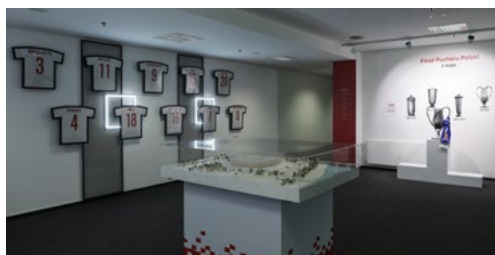

The University of Warsaw Botanic Garden

The University of Warsaw Botanic Garden was founded in 1818. It is one of the oldest and smallest botanical gardens in Poland. It is situated in the central and historical area of the capital – the Royal Route – neighboring Łazienki Park.

7. Warsaw Praga

Finish with a visit to Saska Kępa, an atmospheric neighbourhood full of modernist architecture and home to restaurants offering cuisine from all around the world.

Warsaw Breweries

It was here, in 1846, that the Haberbusch and Schiele brewery was founded and quickly became the capital's "promised land." The brewery, the largest in the Kingdom of Poland and one of the most important on the brewing map of Europe, operated until World War II.

World War II completely devastated this area. Skeletons of bombed tenement houses took away the beauty of this former pride of the city. The post-war fate of the site was of no concern to anyone, and although the brewery itself continued to operate (changing names and owners), and in the years of the deepest socialism it produced coca-cola under American license (sic!), it eventually collapsed, and with it, the whole area fell into oblivion.

For many years this part of Warsaw's Wola which is closest to Śródmieście Północ, was an area almost entirely forgotten by the residents of Warsaw. The Grand Opening of Warsaw Breweries, after their 7 years long renovation, was held in the spring of 2021. The renovated historic Malt House became home to NINE's Restaurant & Sports Bar (Robert Lewandowski is one of the owners of this restaurant), and newly renovated Cellars welcomed Food Hall Browary as their host, with 12 different culinary and bar venues. Warsaw's Wola district has gained a beautiful, open, and friendly place for everyone.

Warsaw Chopin Airport

Warsaw Chopin Airport is the largest airport in Poland. It handles international and domestic traffic, accommodating scheduled, low-cost, charter and cargo carriers. In 2022, the Warsaw airport served 14,413,889 passengers, 145,893 flight operations and 111,000 tonnes of cargo.

Chopin Airport currently has 125 scheduled destinations in 52 countries and 40 charter destinations in 15 countries for the summer 2023 season. Flights are operated by 23 scheduled and 12 charter carriers. The Warsaw airport is also the main base of Poland's national carrier, LOT Polish Airlines.

Chopin Airport is managed by Polish Airports SA (PPL S.A.), which is the leading entity of aviation transport infrastructure in Poland, taking an active part in shaping and developing this strategic sector of the economy.
