
Jazeera Airways to connect Prague with Kuwait

Jazeera Airways, a fast-growing low-cost airline in the Middle East region, will launch **flights between Prague and Kuwait in June 2022**. The airline will fly between the two countries **twice a week**, every Tuesday and Sunday. The carrier will deploy Airbus A320Neo aircraft for 174 passengers on the route. The **very first direct air connection** between the two countries will open Prague to part of the Persian Gulf with considerable potential for inbound tourism. Thanks to Jazeera Airways, passengers can enjoy not only direct flights to Kuwait, but also connections to more distant destinations, especially India, one of the strongest markets without direct flights from Prague. Prague will again have direct connection with Azerbaijan

Azerbaijan Airlines (AZAL) will launch a seasonal flight **between Baku and Prague** from **June 17**. Tickets are already on sale. The new route will operate **twice a week**, on Mondays and Fridays. The carrier expects to deploy the Airbus A320 on the route. No other carrier flies to Azerbaijan from Prague. Source: AZAL

A new 36-meter-long pier was built by the Smetana embankment under the municipal library. It is equipped with columns for connecting vessels to electricity and drinking water. Boats can stay at the dock for **up to 48 hours**. There was no public dock for visitors arriving by boat in Děčín in the past.
